Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome back after, what I hope for you all, was a great summer. It has been lovely to see all the children return to school looking extremely smart, happy and ready for another busy year. There are just a few pieces of information I wanted to share with you that I hope you will find useful:

My Happy Mind

I am pleased to announce that this year we will be introducing an NHS backed program to all year groups at school called myHappymind. MyHappymind is based around helping children to understand how their brain works and to support them in developing positive skills and habits to be their very best selves! Further information about this exciting new programme will be sent home to parents in a separate letter.

Attendance - Every Day Counts!

This year we will continue to be working hard with our children and families to ensure our attendance continues to improve. Significant changes to penalty notices for unauthorised absences during term time came into force from 19 August 2024. In summary, penalty notice fines have increased from £60/£120 to £80/£160 and the threshold for issuing a penalty notice is now a minimum of 10 sessions (5 days) over a 10 week (100 session) period. I would like to remind parents that the law gives no entitlement to parents to take their children on holiday during term time. As head teacher, I do not have the authority to authorise absences for holidays or related activities, unless there are 'exceptional' circumstances. Full details of the changes can be found in updated Attendance Policy on the school website.

Parental Involvement

Parents and family members of children who are due to receive an award will be invited to join us for our Friday celebration assembly. A text message will be sent home if your child has been selected. This year, Celebration assembly will take place at **8.55am every Friday**.
