Welcome back to the Spring Term.
Below are details of the key learning your child will be experiencing this term.

ENGLISH	Katie Goes to London and Katie Goes to Scotland – Ordering and recounting the story, writing postcards, fact files and then innovating our own story based on these stories. SPAG – Adding the suffix ‘ing’ and ‘ed’ to words, using capital letters, full stops and question marks. Phonics – Sound /or/ /ue/ /ar/
MATHEMATICS	Addition and Subtraction Number bonds to 10 Number facts with 10 Missing numbers in equations and the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.
SCIENCE	Plants Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
GEOGRAPHY	United Kingdom Use basic geographical vocabulary- human and physical features. Use maps, atlas and globes to identify the UK and its countries, as well as the continents and oceans. Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding area.
R.E.	Easter Lent Holy Week - Palm Sunday, The Last Supper, Good Friday, Easter Sunday
P.S.H.E	Me and my Relationships Harold has a bad day. Around and about the school. Taking care of something. Harold’s money How should we look after our money?
P.E.	Boccia and Football PE day is Tuesday and Friday. Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE kit for this session.
MUSIC	By the Sea Understand that music can be used to represent an environment. Select instructions to match seaside sounds. Recognise and use dynamics and temp.
ART	Sculpture and 3D – Paper Play Roll paper tubes and attach them to a base securely. Shape paper strips in a variety of ways to make 3D drawings. Create a tree of life sculpture that includes several different techniques for shaping paper. Work successfully with others, sustaining effort over a time.
