

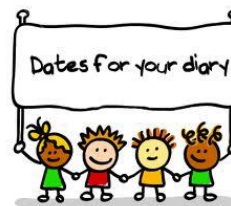
This half term has been a busy one full of many exciting and engaging enrichment activities for our children including the launch of My Happy Mind and our new Forest Schools Programme.
