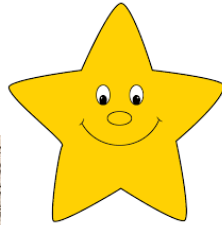

Ethan's Grow £1 Challenge

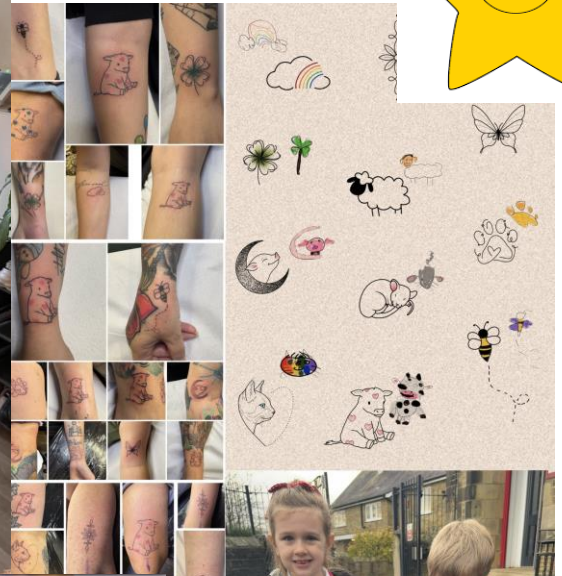
With his £1 Ethan bought a book of raffle tickets.
