

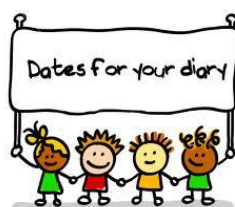
Rehearsals for our upcoming Christmas productions are in full swing here at school and our children are really looking forward to sharing them with you to help get us all into the festive spirit!

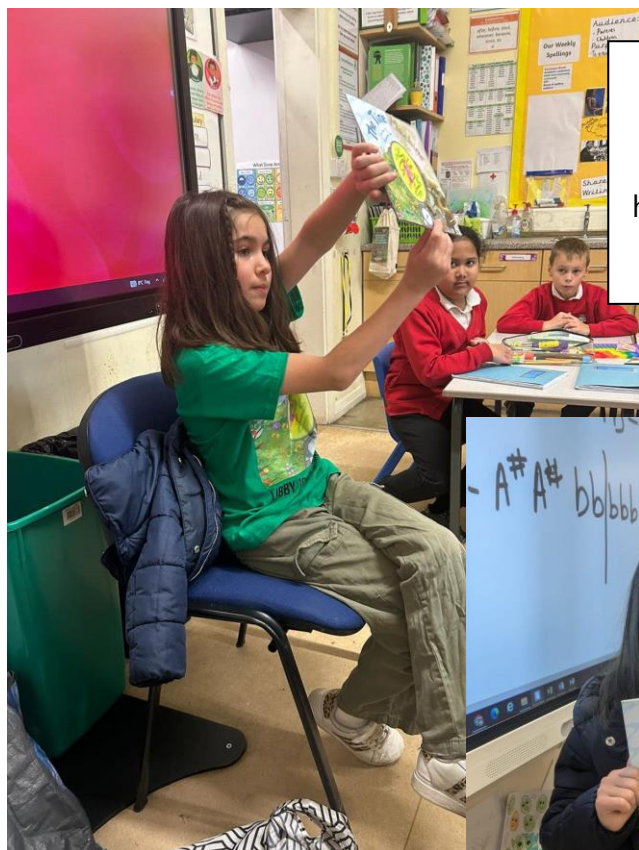
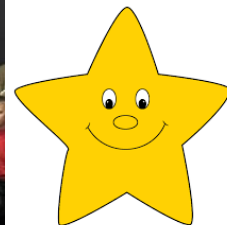
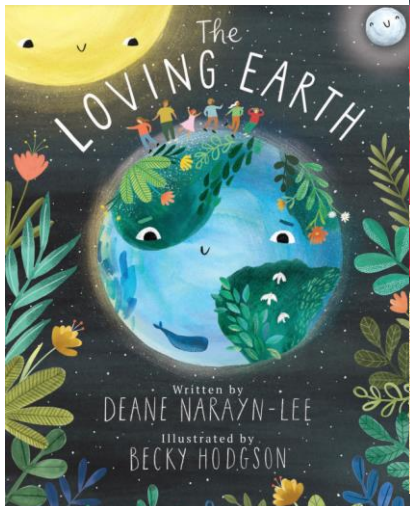
