'Through the school's personal, social and health education programme, pupils develop an assured understanding of how to stay safe online and an age-appropriate awareness of healthy relationships.'


A big thank you for all your support towards our annual summer fayre. A great time was had by all and an impressive amount of money raised for school funds.
