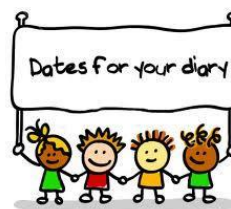


It is hard to believe we are at the end of our third week back in school. All our children have settled into their new classes incredibly well. It was lovely to see so many of you at our class open sessions this week.
