MATHEMATICS	<p>Addition and Subtraction</p> <p>Number bonds to 10</p> <p>Number facts with 10</p> <p>Missing numbers in equations and the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.</p>
SCIENCE	<p>Plants</p> <p>Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.</p> <p>Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.</p>
GEOGRAPHY	<p>United Kingdom</p> <p>Use basic geographical vocabulary- human and physical features.</p> <p>Use maps, atlas and globes to identify the UK and its countries, as well as the continents and oceans.</p> <p>Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding area.</p>
