Finally, a reminder that we have our reception class assembly next Wednesday 29th April at 9am.

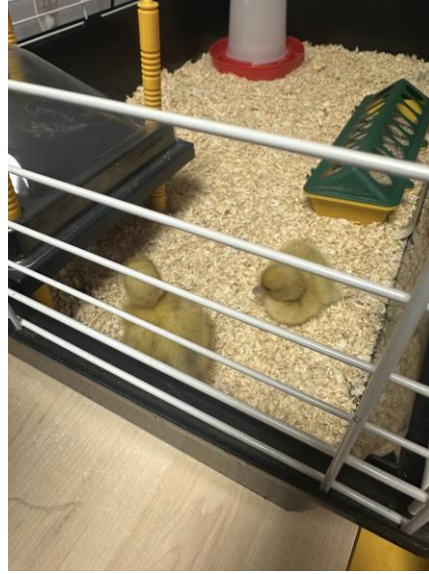
