Summer 2 – CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Welcome back, we hope you had a lovely holiday.
Below are details of the key learning your child will be experiencing this term.

TOPIC	Our topic this term will be Farms and growing in the UK. We will start this half term by learning about farms and what is on a farm. We will learn about animals and their young and learn about farm animal plant lifecycles.
ENGLISH	- Phonics- sounds write- continue initial code- read and write cvc, ccvc, cvcc words, phrases and sentences, recapping two letters one sound ch, sh, th, ck, wh, ng, q-u (2 sounds) - Write our own simple sentences- using capital letter, finger spaces and full stops - Talk in full sentences- to retell familiar stories or own experiences - Letter formation- through letter families and a focus about sitting letters on a line. - Reading and writing our 'Buzz Words'
MATHEMATICS	- Counting forwards and backwards to 30. - Count objects and match to the numeral. - Know number bonds to 5 and 10- including missing number. - Recognise the teen numbers and begin to show them as 10 and x makes.
UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD	- Name animals and their young. - Explore where food comes from. - Looking after our world 2D and 3D shapes- name, recognise, talk about 2D shapes in 3D shapes.
R.E.	How do we understand and care for the world? Religious beliefs and stories about creation will be explored and children will explore how believers value and take care of the world due to their beliefs about creation.
P.E.	PE will take place on a Friday. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit for these sessions- Black/Navy joggers or shorts, white t-shirt and either black or navy sweatshirt or red school jumper. Trainers may be worn, as some sessions will take place outside.
MUSIC	Our focus is Big Band- we will be learning about different instruments and will listen to music from an orchestra and talk about the different instruments.
ART and DT	In DT we will complete a unit around food, making bread and soup and trying a range of different fruits and vegetables.
PSHE	This half term we are learning about Growing and Changing. - Seasons - Life stages – plants, animals, humans - Life stages – Human life stage – who will I be? - Where do babies come from? - Getting bigger
