Summer 2 – CURRICULUM INFORMATION

Below are details of the key learning your child will be experiencing this half term.

ENGLISH	Writing to entertain This half term we will be writing to entertain that will be centred around the seaside and our trip to Lytham. The children will be producing a postcard about their trip. The children will be reading 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch' and learning to write calligram poems.
MATHS	In Maths we will be learning the following: • Time • Position and direction • Doubling, halving, quotative and partitive division • Measure, Volume and Capacity
SCIENCE	Living things and their habitats Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats. Explain how different habitats provide basic needs for animals and plants. The children will be applying their previous knowledge from Spring 1 and Spring 2.
R.E	How and why do some people pray? Children will be looking at how people pray and the difference between what is done and what is said during prayers.
GEOGRAPHY	UK Map and the seaside This links to our school trip this half term to the seaside. We are going to visit Lytham. Children will be revisiting countries and cities of the UK. Then we will explore seaside resorts in the UK and describe the features such as beach, cliff, sand, castle, promenade etc.
P.E.	PE day is every Thursday . Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit and this kit is labelled. This half term is Athletics.
MUSIC	British songs on the island Children will be working together in groups to produce and perform different music that represents an environment.
ART/ DT	Making a moving monster We will be exploring mechanisms. children will be designing a monster which will move using a linkage mechanism and produce their creations.
