Welcome back to the final half term! Where has this year gone! We can't believe we are in our final half term together. Below are details of the key learning your child will be experiencing this term.

ENGLISH	This half term, our learning will link to our history topic, The Vikings. We will be: • Writing to Entertain, creating stories from the Viking fathers • Writing character descriptions and creating our own Viking character • Creating a story involving our Viking character • Writing to persuade: Trip Advisor review of Viking Britain • Writing to inform/ instructional writing: Building Longboats Spelling, punctuation and grammar will also be taught to meet the requirements of the types of writing we will focus on this half term.
MATHEMATICS	We will be learning how to divide using a written method, and solve problems involving money and notation of money • Solve division problems involving remainders and interpret remainders in the context of the question. • Use known multiplication and division facts to solve calculations and check answers using the inverse operations. • Estimate, compare and calculate different amounts of money in pounds and pence. • Solve two-step problems involving money, including giving change and finding the total cost of multiple items.
SCIENCE	Our science for this half term is Electricity, we will be: • identifying common appliances that run on electricity • constructing a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers • investigating which materials are electrical conductors or insulators • explaining how a switch works in a circuit, building switches and reporting findings • discussing and solving problems about electricity using reasoning skills
HISTORY	This half term we will be learning about The Vikings! We will learn about: • where the Vikings came from and where they settled • The battles that The Vikings won (and lost!) • Viking Settlements • Trade and Viking Longships • Viking towns and areas in the UK • The language of Viking Runes
R.E.	Our theme for this half term is: Why are Gurus at the heart of Sikh belief and practice?
